Visiting Policies

Our visiting policies are designed to provide patients with meaningful visits. They take into account each patient's individual treatment needs, the age of the patient, patient confidentiality as well as the needs of all patients. We continue to maintain appropriate Covid precautions for the health of both patients and staff.

- Visitors must bring a photo I.D. to verify identity.
- Visitors are highly encouraged to prescheduled in advance with unit staff.
- Three visitors are permitted at a time.
- Minors must be accompanied by their parent(s).
- Visitors need to arrive on time, late arrivals may not be accommodated.

Food Policies

- Snacks and small meals are permitted. Large quantities can not be accommodated.
- Staff will conduct a visual check of food. For safety of unit, TaraVista may deny certain food items
- Food brought in can only be consumed by patient at time of visit.
- Items prohibited: food with nuts, no caffeine products, plastic bags, glass bottles or cans.
- Drinks must sealed and unopened.

Prohibited Items

- Items that are not allowed on the unit can be stored in a secure locker located in the lobby.
- Prohibited items include: wallet | purse | plastic bags | keys | coats | laptops, cellphones, tablets | earbuds, headphones | cans, glass containers | caffeinated products | lighters, matches | pocketknives | medications
- Weapons, nicotine products, alcohol, cannabis, and other drugs are not allowed on the premises.
